KENILWORTH, NJ

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans Affairs has confirmed that Kieran Cannady, a resident of Kenilworth who resides at 586 Passaic Avenue (Block 139, Lot 18) was granted a determination of 100% total disability by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, and

WHEREAS, Kieran Cannady has made an application to the Tax Assessor for an exemption from property taxes on the above address based on their disabled veteran's status under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the tax assessor, Kevin Palumbo, in a letter dated December 30, 2024, to the tax collector that Kieran Cannady shall be granted full tax exemption from billed property taxes as of December 17, 2024, and this has resulted in an overpayment of 2024 and 2025 taxes due;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Kenilworth, County of Union, State of New Jersey, that Kieran Cannady shall be granted a full tax exemption from property taxes billed to 586 Passaic Avenue Kenilworth, NJ, as of December 17, 2024, and that the following overpayment of taxes be paid:
