KENILWORTH, NJ

WHEREAS, the Holland Township has reached out to the Chief of the Kenilworth Volunteer Fire Department requesting donations of any radio equipment that is in surplus and no longer in use by our fire department; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Kenilworth Fire Chief has acknowledged that all Kenilworth public safety agencies and the Kenilworth DPW are now operating on the New Jersey State Police PSCIC System and this system required the purchase of all new radios for the entire borough

WHEREAS, the Kenilworth Volunteer Fire Department Chief has identified numerous radios purchased sporadically from 1997 to 2017 that are no longer in use and would like to donate this equipment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to New Jersey Local Public Contact Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-36(2), a municipality is permitted to convey property no longer needed for public use to other political entities without public sale; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to the surplus radios to the Holland Township Volunteer Fire.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough of Kenilworth does hereby authorize the donation of the surplus radios that no longer have an intrinsic value to the Kenilworth Volunteer Fire Department to Holland Township for use in their volunteer fire department.
