

**RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans Affairs has confirmed that Gerald Schemel, a resident of Kenilworth who resides at 358 Lincoln Drive (Block 105, Lot 13) was granted a determination of 100% total disability by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, and

WHEREAS, Gerald Schemel has made an application to the Tax Assessor for an exemption from property taxes on the above address based on their disabled veteran's status under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30; and


