

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF KENILWORTH AMENDING THE EXISTING CHAPTER 106 "GARBAGE, RUBBISH, REFUSE AND RECYCLING", ARTICLE I "COLLECTION AND REMOVAL", WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF KENILWORTH, COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 106-6 Receptacle Requirements and 106-7 Hours of Collection to reflect current standards and practices.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Kenilworth, County of Union, State of New Jersey as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, Existing Chapter 106 "Garbage, Rubbish, Refuse and Recycling", Article I "Collection and Removal" be amended as follows, strike through verbiage to be removed:

§ 106-6 Receptacle Requirements.

~~All garbage and rubbish shall be deposited in a metal container which shall be watertight and equipped with tightfitting covers of metal. The metal container shall not be more than 30 inches in height, and the diameter of said container shall not be more than 20 inches. The combined weight of the receptacle and the contents shall not exceed 75 pounds.~~, as defined, shall be deposited by the owner in a standard suitable container or bundle curbside. Suitable container is defined to be a metal, rubber or plastic receptacle with a tight-fitting cover, so constructed as to prevent spilling or leaking of its contents. Each receptacle for use in a single residence shall have a capacity of not less than twenty (20) no more than thirty (30) gallons and be equipped with a pull handle or handles. Plastic bags of any capacity and grade may not be used for the disposal of wet garbage. The total weight of any container shall not exceed seventy-five (75) pounds.

NOW THEREFORE, Existing Chapter 106 "Garbage, Rubbish, Refuse and Recycling", Article I "Collection and Removal" , be amended as follows:

§ 106-7 Hours of Collection: placement and removal of receptacles.

106-7 A Collections shall start no earlier than ~~5:00~~ 4:30 a.m.

Severability

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage as provided by law.
