Inspection from the Fire Prevention Bureau for all 1 and 2 family dwellings prior to change of ownership and or occupancy.

Inspection Fee - Sale of 2 family home	\$160.00

Inspection Fee - Sale of 2 family home	\$210.00
Requested less than time period of 1 week with 1 re-inspection	

Inspections requiring more than 1 re-inspection will be required to pay a second fee.

IF YOUR HOME HAS BATTERY OPERATED SMOKE DETECTORS THIS APPLIES:

****PLEASE NOTE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2019:**** Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:70-4.19:

Ten year sealed battery powered single station smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are now required. Therefore, all non-sealed battery operated smoke and carbon monoxide detectors must be replaced. 10 year battery operated smoke/CO detectors are required on each level and outside of all bedroom areas.

Electric powered single or multiple station smoke and carbon monoxide alarms shall not be replaced with battery detectors. All electric detectors must be replaced after 10 years. Date of manufacture on underside of detector. Electric carbon monoxide detectors or electric smoke/carbon monoxide detectors are required on each level and adjacent to any fuel burning appliance.

SECONDARY POWER SOURCE: Homes with a permanently installed generator, solar panels, battery storage system, or other secondary power source must have a label installed within 18 inches of the main electrical panel AND electric meter indicating there are multiple sources of power. The label cannot be handwritten.
